1. Membership Status and Key Tags

☐ Age of new members – Under 18's will not be given RFID tokens and should not be down the range by themselves (there are some case-by-case exceptions for under 18s (i.e. training for international tournaments))

2. Access and Alarm

Ц	All members are responsible for unlocking and locking up of the club house & setting the
	alarm code / roller door (including keeping the club house locked and put the roller door
	down when shooting at all times so passers by, cannot acess)

- ☐ Reminder that the club is 24hr access.
- □ Key for toilets are no longer needed but the car park gate key is still the key chained to the block of steel located on the shelf on the immediate right as you open the door. The toilet doors are to be closed after use; the code to these is the same as the Alarm. The toilet doors will be opened for Come N Try on Sundays and closed by the coaches when it is finished.

The locks remain on the toilet door for unforseen usage and to lock the slide bolts open *Note: Gate padlocks remain on gate when unlocked but locked back to the other padlocks or the fixed ring, toilet padlocks are to be left where they are and are no longer unlocked for any reason.

- ☐ Members to lock up the clubhouse, toilet doors pulled shut and gate locked if they are the last one at the range when leaving.
- ☐ Gate to be locked if you're the last car out, even if there are others still shooting.

3. Club Facilities

- * Notice Boards advertising upcoming club, local and interstate events.
- * Toilet Key
- * Range and indoor light and switches

- * Sign in book (Including \$5 fee for guests of the club (Guests must write down their

AA or other membership number)

- * Target Faces and Pins
- * Rubbish bins (If you find them full, please empty them. A poster is above sign-in showing you where)
- * Drinks fridge (All caned and bottled drinks are available for purchase, prices are on the fridge door. All monies for drink and club merchandise is to be deposited in the cash slot on shelf near light switches next to door) We have new pay-pal QR code for purchases if cash not convenient.
- * The workshop equipment should not be used by members without assistance from someone experienced.

4. Shoot rules and etiquette

No running on the range, stop shooting when people walk across
Shoot from either the front yellow line or the red undercover line (5 metres
back). Each lane is marked with either a blue or red dash with a series of
matching blue or red bricks. To shoot independent to another member who
is already shooting, leave a 2 lane gap when on the same line or a three
lane gap if shooting from the line in front of behind another archer. If range is
busy keep in step with the other archers in the adjoining lanes.
